12. Adjournment (*Next Regular Meeting: July 21, 2020. -- Regular Meeting*)

Public Comment Policy Participants will be limited to five minutes duration. No participant may speak more than once on the same topic unless all others who wish to speak on the topic have been heard. Participants shall direct comments to the Board and not to staff or other participants. The portion of the meeting during which the participation of the public is invited shall be limited to 20 minutes, unless extended. The presiding officer may interrupt, warn, or terminate a participant's statement when the statement is too lengthy, personally directed, abusive, obscene, or irrelevant; request any individual to leave the meeting when the person does not observe reasonable decorum; request the assistance of law enforcement officers in the removal of a disorderly person when the person's conduct interferes with the orderly progress of the meeting; call for a recess or an adjournment to another time when the lack of public decorum so interferes with the orderly conduct of the meeting as to warrant such action.
