## **Contracted Job Requirements**

Buckley Community Schools is looking for a full time mental health professional with one of the following licenses to contract with the school to support students during the school year; Licensed master's level professional counselor or psychologist, limited licensed professional counselor or psychologist under the supervision of a licensed master's level professional counselor or psychologist, licensed master's level social worker, or a limited licensed master's level social worker under the supervision of a licensed master's level social worker.

Job requirements will be to administer necessary behavioral health assessments to determine a student's need for mental health services. These services may include but are not limited to working with students who are experiencing one or more of the following; suicidal thoughts, anxiety disorders, depression, eating disorders, substance abuse, attention deficit disorder, grief and/or trauma.

Will develop a goal oriented treatment plan, with the student and parents/guardians as appropriate and provide behavioral health counseling services.

Continually monitor the effectiveness of the goals and objectives of the treatment plan to make sure the goals are being met.

Additional job requirements may be added by the superintendent as needed.

Applicant must be able to work during the school week, Monday through Friday of the school year.
